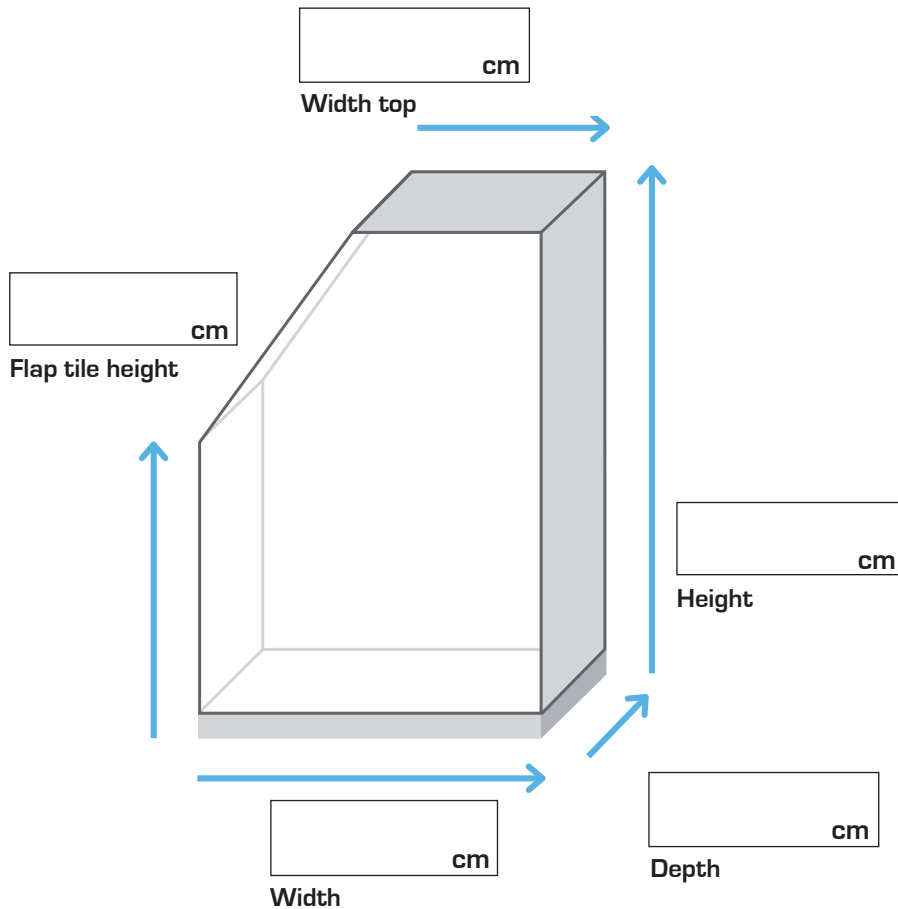


Measuring instructions: Cupboard with slope on left

Step 1:

Enter the measurements (cm) into the relevant boxes:



Resources required:

Tape measure or **stick**, **pencil** and the printed **measuring instructions**

How to measure correctly:

Draw the cupboard 1:1 on the back wall and measure the height and width at several locations, in each case taking the smallest measurement.

"Space" for problem-free assembly:

Your cupboard must be at least **3 cm lower** and **4 cm narrower** than the room or niche. The distance to the sloping ceiling must be **3 cm**.

Deeper due to doors:

The depth measurement refers to the body, if you are planning doors the cupboard depth increases **by 2 cm**.

To be clear draw the cupboard's shape on the wall with a pencil. You can protect the wall with protective tape.

Step 2:
